

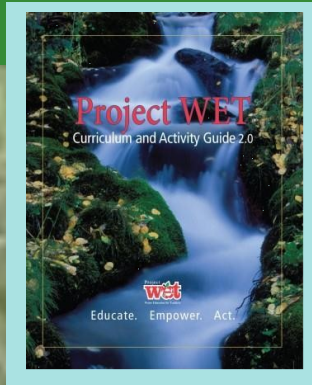


Project WET for Educators Saturday, June 24, 2017 all day at the Truckee River!

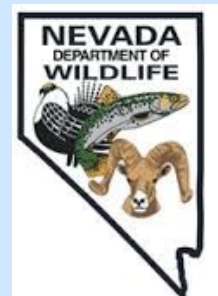
Reminders & Driving Directions:

Wear: We'll be learning in our great Nevada outdoors all day, so wear comfy outdoor layers, sunscreen, and a hat or visor for the sun. You may want something like Tevas for our water time. Be ready to go from cool to hot and back again.

Bring: Water in refillable water bottle. We try to be "green" and discourage using bottled water. Bring your sack lunch, extra sunscreen, an extra layer to wear, & a pen or pencil, all ideally in a little daypack. A folding lawn chair may enhance your comfort in the shade on the lawn.

Driving Directions: Please allow time to arrive by **9:00 AM** ready to start at Mayberry Park at the end of Woodland Ave. in west Reno. From W. 4th St., turn left onto Woodland Ave., just west of Mayberry Drive. This river park is a beautiful day-use facility with various individual picnic sites, a group picnic area, a paved bike path, hiking trails, and Truckee River fishing access. Bird-watching, hiking, bike riding, river tubing and picnicking are popular activities here. Handicap-accessible, this park is located just four miles west of Reno, at 121 Woodland Avenue. Parking is limited, so carpooling is appreciated. Class ends by 5:30.
